## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Artwork can be entered into **any one category 1to 8** above *and* **category 9**. Costumes will only be accepted in the **Luminescence** category if they are UV light sensitive. Please be aware that your costume may be removed from this category if it is not considered appropriate. Please consult with the director before entering a costume into this category.
- ***If an insufficient number of entries is received for a category to warrant a competition, that category will be closed and the entry will be placed in another category in consultation with the artist.***
- **All artwork/costumes must be viewed by the Artistic Director by 17<sup>th</sup> August 2009. Please contact her on 08 91935639 if you have any queries regarding this. If your work is not seen by this date it will not be allowed in the show. Please deliver all artworks to 29 Solway loop or mail to: Gwen Knox PO Box 5122, Broome 6726**
- Artists may submit any number of entries into the event. Please use one entry form per entry and ensure that all details are completed and correct.
- Entry fee per costume entry is \$15, or \$10 (Student or Concession Card Holder) or \$5 (child entry made by the child). Please attach the entry fee to the entry form.
- Cheques or money orders are welcome, please make payable to: ***Theatre Kimberley Worn Art.***
- All monies paid will be receipted appropriately. No EFTPOS or credit facilities are available.
- Entry forms unaccompanied by the entry fee will **NOT** be accepted.
- Closing date for entry forms (returned by mail) is ***Monday 10th August at 5.00pm.***
- Entries will NOT be accepted past the closing deadline.
- Each artwork entry is entitled to one free ticket on a night of the Artist's choice.
- **Models must be prepared to attend ALL rehearsals.**
- All artwork will be automatically eligible for judging in the nominated category, the Overall Winner category and People's Choice Category.
- **If there are 2 or more costumes to an entry, it must be entered into category 7.**
- Committee members who are paid for their work on Worn Art are not eligible to win prizes.
- Organisers reserve the right to use photos of all artworks and performers submitted for promotional and marketing purposes.
- The Judges' decisions are final.
- Prizes are not redeemable for cash.
- Reasonable care will be taken with entries but the Worn Art committee will accept no responsibility for damage or loss and insurance is the responsibility of the artist.
